CHAINS	
	Va. 19°30'E.
	East, on random line between sections 10 and 15. Along steep side hill N. side, broken.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
62.00	Begin descent.
80.60	Intersect N. and S. line, 70 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15. Thence I run S.89°30'W., on a true line between sections 10 and 15, with same variation.
40.30	Set a stone, 12x12x8 ins., 9 ins. in ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the N. side for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which A cedar, 20 ins. diam., bears S.45°W., 12 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears N.44°E., 16 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
80.60	To the corner to sections 9, 10, 15 and 16. Land, mountainous and broken. Soil, rocky, third and fourth rates. Timber, thick undergrowth of same kinds of wood with hazel and yew. Dense forests of fir, cedar and laurel.

	North, on random line between sections 9 and 10. Steep descent.
16.20	A creek, 12 lks. wide, C E. Ascent.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
42.00	Steep ascent.
81.62	To a point, 706 lks. East of the established corner for sections 3, 4, 9 and 10, which is a post, set in a mound of rock and from which I run South 5°03'E., on a true line between sections 9 and 10, with same variations.
