A Chinquapin, 7 ins. diam., bears N.25*E., 21 lks.
 Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 9 B T.

A Dogwood, 4 ins. diam., bears S.21*E., 13 lks.
 Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 16 B T.

A Maple, 6 ins. diam., bears S.65*W., 30 lks.
 Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 17 B T.

A Chinquapin, 5 ins. diam., bears N.12*W., 11 lks.
 Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 8 B T.

Land, broken and mountainous.
 Soil, rocky, third and fourth rates.
 Covered with dense forest of Fir, Cedar and Laurel.
 Thick undergrowth of same kind of wood with Maple,
 Dogwood, Hazel, Chinquapin, etc.
