CHAINS

- 43.00 A Creek, 1 lk. wide, c NW. Begin ascent.
- 55.00 Top of Spur, c N. descend NW. slope.
- 79.60 A Creek, 10 lks. wide; c N.75°E.
- 85.23 Intersect West Bdy. of township, 15 lks. North of cor. to sections 19, 24, 25 & 30, which is a post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set in ground, marked
T 31 S R 5 W S 19 on NE. face, S 30 on SE. face,
S 25 on S W. face, R 6 W S 24 on NW. face, from which
A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.63°E., 35 lks. dist.
Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 19 B T.
A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.68°E., 50 lks. dist.
Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 30 B T.
A Hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears S.67°W., 32 lks.
Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 25 B T.
A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.62°W., 71 lks. dist.
Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 24 B T.
- Thence, I run
N.89°54'E., on a true line between sections 19 & 30,
with same var.
- 45.23 Set a Fir post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 18 ins. in ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on the N. face, from which
A Fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.56°E., 28 lks, dist.
Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
A Fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S.54°E., 61 lks.
Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- 85.23 To the cor. to secs. 19, 20, 29 & 30.
Land, mountainous.
Soil, second, and third rate.
Timber, dense forest of Fir, Cedar, Yew, Laurel, Hemlock,
and Maple.
Thick undergrowth of same kinds of wood with Hazel,
Arrow-wood and Live Oak.
