- T 31 S R 6 W S 24 on NE.
- S 25 on SE.
- S 26 on SW.
- S 23 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on E. and 2 notches on S. edges, from which
- A Fir, 50 ins. dia., bears N.42\*E., 72 lks. dis. mkd. T 31 S R 6 W S 24 B T.
- A Fir, 48 ins. dia., bears S.45\*E., 19 lks. dis. mkd. T 31 S R 6 W S 25 B T.
- A Fir, 16 ins. dia., bears S.64\*W., 72 lks. dis. mkd. T 31 S R 6 W S 26 B T.
- A Chinkapin, 12 ins. dia., bears N.53\*W., 96 lks. dis. mkd. T 31 S R 6 W S 23 B T.
- Land, mountainous and broken.
- Soil, 3rd rate.
- Timber, mostly burned.
- Thick undergrowth of Laurel, Live Oak, Fir and Pine.
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- Va. 19\*30'E.
- East, on random line bet. secs. 24 and 25.
- 2.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE.
- 17.00 Creek, 5 lks. wide, from N.85\*W. to N.85\*E.
- 35.00 Same, Course S.85\*E.
- 39.75 Same, course N.85\*E.
- 40.00 Set temporary  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor.
- 56.80 Same creek, course S.85\*E.
- 80.68 Intersect E. boundary of Tp., 72 lks. N. of cor. to Secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, which is a post 4 ins. sq., set firmly in the ground and marked.
