- 75.20 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S.
- 80.76 Intersect Tp. line, 18 lks. N. of cor. to secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, which is a post 3 ins. sq. set firmly in the ground and Marked
- T 31 S 18 on NE.
- R 5 W S 19 on SE.
- R 6 W S 24 on SW. and
- S 13 on NW. faces with 3 notches N. & S. edges, from which
- A Laurel, 8 ins. dia., bears N.41\*W., 41 lks. dis. mkd. T 31 S R 6 W., S. 13 B T.
- A Laurel, 6 ins. dia., bears S.55\*W., 64 lks. dis. mkd. T 31 S R 6 W S 24 B T.
- A Live Oak, 10 ins. dia., bears N.43\*E., 40 lks. dis. mkd. T 31 S R 5 W S 18 B T.
- A Fir, 36 ins. dia., bears S.29\*E., 55 lks. dis. mkd. T 31 S R 5 W S 19 B T.
- Thence I run N.89\*52\*W., on true line bet. secs. 13 and 24.
- Va. 18\*30'E.
- 40.38 A stone 40x24x18, which I marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., from which
- A Fir, 14 ins. dia., bears N.25\*W., 32 lks. dis. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- A Live Oak, 12 ins. dia., bears S.2\*E., 32 lks. dis. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- 80.76 The cor. to secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24.
- Land, mountainous, Soil, 3rd rate.
- Timber, mostly Fir, with some Pine and Laurel.
- Thick undergrowth of Laurel and Fir, with Live Oak and Manzanita.
