A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears S. 66*W., 117 lks. dist.,
marked T 31 S R 6 W S 11 B T.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.62*W., 64 lks. dist.,
marked T 31 S R 6 W S 2 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, laurel and cedar.

Thick undergrowth of fir, laurel, pine, cedar, hazel
and balm.

Va.19*30'E.

East, on random line, bet. secs. 12 and 1.

Ascend to

- 5.00 Thence along side hill facing S.
- 25.00 Ascend.
- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 50.25 Top of ridge, course N and S.
Very steep descent to
- 65.50 Thence along very steep side hill facing N to
- 80.20 Intersect Tp. line, 64 lks. S of cor. to secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12,
which is a post, 3 ins. sq., firmly set in the
ground and marked
T 31 S R 5 W S 6 on NE
S 7 on SE
R 6 W S 12 on SW and
S 1 on NW faces, with 1 notch on N and 5 notches on

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.77*W., 60 lks. dist.,
marked T 31 S R 6 W S 12 B T.
