40.00	Set tem. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
44.60	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. E. Thence along steep side hill facing N.
49.00	Steep descent.
54.75	Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N.
55.25	Wagon Road, course N. Steep ascent.
80.32	Intersect N. and S. line, 39 lks. N. of Cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12. Thence I run N.89*43'W., on true line bet. secs. 2 and 11, with same variation.
40.16	Set a stone 20x10x5, 12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which A Live Oak, 12 ins. in dia., bears N.4*W., 69 lks. dis. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Live Oak, 5 ins. in dia., bears S.15*E., 25 lks. dis. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
