S 20 on SW., and S 17 on NW. faces, with 4 notches on E. and 3 notches on S. edges, from which A Laurel, 14 ins. dia., bears N.50*E., 46 lks. dis. mkd. T 31 S R 6 W S 16 B T. A Laurel, 10 ins. dia., bears S.51*E., 64 lks. dis. mkd. T 31 S R 6 W S 21 B T. A Laurel, 20 ins. dia., bears S.40*W., 103 lks. dis. mkd. T 31 S R 6 W S 20 B T.
