A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.65*E., 12 lks. dist. marked T 31 S R 7 W S 30 B T.

A Fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.45*W., 60 lks. dist. marked T 31 S R 8 W S 25 B T.

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.42*W., 20 lks. dist. marked T 31 S R 8 W S 24 B T.
