37.50	Top of spur, c. N. Descend.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor.
70.40	Creek, 8 lks. wide, C. N. Very steep ascent.
79.40	Intersect East boundary of Township, 30 lks. S. of Cor. to Secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, which is a post 4 ins. sq., set firmly in the ground and marked T 31 S R 6 W S 7 on NE; S 18 on SE; R 7 W S 13 on SW and S12 on NW faces, with 2 notches on N. and 4 notches on S. edges, from which A Laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears N.76*E., 25 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 6 W S 7 B T. A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears S.25*E., 27 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 6 W S 18 B T. A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.62*W., 11 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 7 W S 13 B T. A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears N.18*W., 29 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 7 W S 12 B T. Thence, I run S.89*47*W. on true line bet. secs. 12 and 13.
39.70	Set fir post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 18 ins., in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face from which A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.26*E., 23 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.12*W., 39 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
79.40	The cor. to secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14. Land, mountainous. Soil, 3rd rate. Timber, Fir, pine and laurel. Thick undergrowth of fir, laurel, pine and cedar.
