	Then from the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 on the S. Bdy. of the Tp, which is a post, 4 ins. sq., set firmly in the ground and marked T 31 S R 7 W S 35 on NE; T 32 S S 2 on SE; S 3 on SW and S 34 on NW faces, with 2 notches on E. and 4 notches on W. edges, from which A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears N.12*E., 71 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 7 W S 35 B T. A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears S.85*E., 21 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 7 W S 2 B T. A Laurel, 14 ins. diam., bears S.60*W., 6 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 7 W S 3 B T. A Fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. 54*W., 109 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 7 W S 34 B T. I run North bet. secs. 34 and 35. Va. 19*E.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears S.50*E., 22 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B T.

57.70	Middle Creek, 45 lks. wide, C. W. Ascend.
