80.00 Set a pine post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, marked T 31 S R 7 W S 27 on NE face; S 34 on SE face; S 33 on SW face and S 28 on NW face. Also, one notch on S. and 3 notches on the E. angles of the same for the cor. to secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34 from which

A Pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S.45\*E., 147 lks. dist.

A Pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S.65\*W., 165 lks. dist.

A Pine, 14 ins. diam., bears N.75\*W., 138 lks. dist.

Marked T 31 S R 7 W S 28 B T.

Land, mountainous. Soil, 3rd and 4th rates.

Timber, Fir, Pine, Laurel and Cedar.

Thick undergrowth of Fir, Laurel, Pine and Cedar.

East on random line, bet. secs. 27 and 34.

Va. 18\*30'E.

12.00 Leave prairie and enter timber.

15.75 A creek, 3 lks. wide, C.S.

28.00 A Creek, 6 lks. wide, C. S. Steep ascent.

33.00 Top of hill, along S. slope.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. cor.

55.00 Gradual decent.

69.60 Decend Rocky bluff, 50 ft. high, C. N and S.

70.60 A Creek, 10 lks. wide, C. S. Steep ascent.

76.20 Trail C. N. and S.
