A Laurel, 14 ins. diam., bears S.81*W., 43 lks. dist.

A Cedar, 16, ins., diam., bears N.38*W., 54 lks. dist.

Marked T 31 S R 7 W S 30 B T.

Land, mountainous, rocky, 3rd rate.

Timber, Fir, Pine, Laurel, Cedar and Live Oak.

Thick undergrowth of Fir, Laurel, Live Oak, Cedar and Pine.

East on Random line bet. secs. 29 and 32.
