## CHAINS

West on Random line bet. secs. 18 and 19.

Va. 18°30'E.

- 9.50 Top of spur, C.N. Steep decent.
- 40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.
- 41.00 Cow Creek, 100 lks. wide, C. N.20°E.
- 44.00 R. R. C. S.26 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*W.
- 53.50 Top of ridge, C. N. and S. Decend.
- 79.30 Intersect Tp. line, 70 lks, N. of cor. to secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, Viz. A Laurel post, 4 ins. sq., firmly set in the ground marked T 31 S R 7 W S 18 on NE face; S 19 on SE face; S 24 on SW face and S 13 on NW face. Also 3 notches on the N. and S. angles of the same from which
- A Laurel, 7 ins. diam., bears. N.65°E., 11 lks.  
Marked T 31 S R 7 W S 18 B T.
- A Laurel, 7 ins. diam., bears S.68°E.35 lks. dist.  
Marked T 31 S R 7 W S 19 B T.
- A Laurel, 7 ins. diam., bears S.42°W., 30 lks. dist.  
Marked T 31 S R 8 W S 24 B T.
- A Laurel, 7 ins. diam., bears N.85°W., 24 lks. dist.  
Marked T 31 S R 8 W S 13 B T.
- Thence N.89°30'E., on true line bet. secs. 18 and 19.
- 39.30 Marked a W.Oak, 7 ins. diam.,  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. on N. side for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. from which
- A W.Oak, 4 ins. diam., bears S.8°W., 16 lks.dist.  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- A W.Oak, 4 ins. diam., bears N.10°W., 26 lks. dist.  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- 79.30 To the cor. to secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20.
- Land, mountainous and broken.
- Timber, fir, pine, cedar, laurel and oak.
- Thick undergrowth of fir, laurel, live-oak, cedar and pine.
