East on Random line bet. secs. 8 and 17.
 Va. 18°30'E.

29.00 R. Road, C. S. 21°E.

30.20 Cow Creek, 150 lks. wide, C. N.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

60.00 Top of spur, C. NW. Along NE slope.

80.20 Intersect N. and S. line 60 lks. S. of Cor. secs., 8, 9, 16, and 17. Thence S. 89°34'W., on true line bet. secs. 8 and 17.

40.10 Marked a live-oak, 5 ins. diam., $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. side, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. from which
 A Laurel, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 8°W., 50 lks. dist.
 Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T,
 A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 20°W., 50 lks. dist.
 Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

80.20 To the cor. to secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18.
 Land, mountainous and broken. Soil, rocky, 3rd rate.
 Timbers, fir, pine, cedar and laurel.
 Thick underbrush of fir, pine, laurel, live-oak and balm.

West on Random line bet. secs. 7 and 18.
 Va. 18°30'E.

40.00 Set Temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

45.00 Top of ridge, C. NW and SE. Decend SW slope.

79.20 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp., 88 lks. N. of cor. to secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, which is a pine post, 4 ins. sq., firmly set in the ground, marked T 31 S R 7 W S 7 on NE face; S 18 on SE face; S 13 on SW face, R 8 W S 12 on NW face. Also, 4 notches on S. angle and 2 notches on N. angle of same from which
 A Pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 16°E., 160 lks. dist.
 Marked T 31 S R 7 W S 18 B T.
