

Retracement Portion W. Bdy., T. 31 S., R. 7 W.,

CHAINS

from which

A Yellow Pine, 50 ins. diam., bears S.52*E., 39 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 B T (Old B.T.)

A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.33*W., 49 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 B T (New B.T.)

The true course and length of this line is N.0*04'W., 40.84 chs.

I continue my retracement North from the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., counting distance from the sec. cor.

41.40 Ravine, C. W., ascend.

48.60 Top of rocky point, slopes SW.; thence ascend along W. slope.

53.25 Summit of rocky ridge, bears NW and SE.; descend.

56.55 Trail, bears NW. and SE.

62.30 Trail, bears NW. and SE.

67.20 Head of ravine, course S.70*E.; ascend steep rocky SE slope.

76.35 Top of rocky point, slopes SE.; descend.

79.05 Ravine, course SE.; ascend steep S. slope.

81.91 Fall 1 lk. E. of the cor. of Tps. 30 and 31 S., Rs. 7 and 8 W., heretofore described.

The true course and length of this line from the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. is N.0*01'W., 41.07 chs.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, red clay loam to 42.00 chs., 2nd rate; balance, gravel and rocky loam, 4th rate.

Timber, fir, live oak, madrona and yellow pine.

Undergrowth, fir, arrowwood, chaparral and live oak.
