Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears N.30*W., 25 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T</p>
61.50	Summit on line. Thence descend.

Marked T 31 S R 8 W S 1 B T</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.40*E., 6 lks. dist.
