37.00	Top of Ridge, course NW. & SE.

79.27	Intersect N. & S. line 55 lks. North of corner to Secs. 22, 23, 26 & 27. Thence I run N.89*37'W. on a true line bet. Secs. 22 & 27. With same Var.
39.63	Set a Chincapin post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. side, from which A Laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears S.4*W., 34 lks.dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.45*W., 39 lks.dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
