80.16	Intersect N. & S. line 28 lks. S. of the Cor. to Secs. 15, 16, 21 & 22. Thence I run S.89*48'W. on a True line bet. Secs. 16 & 21. With same Var.
40.08	Set a Fir post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on the N. side, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., from which A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.2*W., 48 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A Laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears N.20*W., 17 lks. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
80.16	The Cor. to Secs. 16, 17, 20 & 21. Land; East mountain side, rocky. Soil, 3d rate. Timber: Dense forest of fir, laurel, cedar, pine, yew and hemlock. Undergrowth, fir, laurel, cedar, pine, yew and hemlock.
	North bet. Secs. 16 & 17. Va. 20* East. East side of mountain near summit.
26.00	Summit, course N.10*E., along W. slope.
40.00	Set a Cedar post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. side for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., from which A Fir, 36 ins., diam., bears East 62 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears West 51 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
50.00	Along Summit of ridge.
60.00	Along E. Slope of Ridge.
74.75	A Creek, 2 lks. wide, course E.
