CHAINS

Timber: Dense forest of fir, pine, laurel, cedar and yew.

Undergrowth, chiefly fir, pine, laurel, cedar and yew.

West on a Random Line bet. Secs. 30 & 31.

Va. 19°15' East.

10.40 A Creek, 5 lks. wide, course SE. Steep Ascent.

40.00 Set Temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor.

46.00 Top of Ridge, course S. Descend.

93.20 Intersect West Boundary of Township 35 lks. North of Cor. to Secs. 25, 30, 31 & 36, which is a fir post 4 in. sq., firmly set in the ground, and marked T 31 S R 8 W S 30 on the NE., S 31 on SE., R 9 W S 36 on SW., and S 25 on NW. faces. Also 1 notch on the South and 5 notches on N. angles of same, and from which

A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.21°E., 90 lks. dist.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.36°E., 80 lks. dist.

Marked T 31 S R 8 W S 31 B T

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.38°W., 13 lks, dist.

Marked T 31 S R 9 W S 36 B T

A Fir, 56 ins. diam., bears N.15°W., 58 lks. dist.

Marked T 31 S R 9 W S 25 B T

Thence I run

N.89°47' E. on a True Line bet. Secs. 30 & 31.

53.20 Set a stone 13x8x6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. side for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., from which

A Fir, 44 ins. diam., bears N.35°E., 67 lks. dist.

Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.65°W., 48 lks. dist.

Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T
