35.00	Enter green timber, course N. & S. Gradual Ascent.

47.00	<p>Top of Dutchmens' Butte. Gradual descent.  Thick undergrowth, chiefly fir.</p>
80.75	<p>Intersect N. &amp; S. line 40 lks. South of Cor. to Secs. 8, 9, 16 &amp; 17.  Thence I run  S.89*43'W. on a True Line bet. Secs. 8 &amp; 17.</p>
