1.50	Babe's Creek 50 lks. wide, course NE.	-500

18.50	Old $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. which is a tree standing, marked and witnessed as per description furnished by the Surveyor General.	
	Enter old burn, course N and S.	+800
22.50	Top of spur, course NE. Descend in green timber.	+100
40.00	Set a Basalt stone 18x12x6, 12 ins. in the ground and marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. from which A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 41 lks. dist., marked S 35 $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.62*W., 48 lks. dist., marked S 35 $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.	-300
50.00	A creek 10 lks. wide, course N.10*E. Steep ascent.	-400
56.25	Old cor. of Secs. 2 and 3, which is a Sugar Pine, 72 ins. in diam., marked and witnessed as per description furnished by the Surveyor General.	
65.00	Enter old burn, gradual ascent.	
80.00	Mark a Chinquapin 5 ins. diam., T 31 S S 35 on NE, R 9 W S 34 on NW and 2 notches on E and four notches on W. sides, for the cor. of Secs. 34 and 35, from which A Laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears N.20*E., 34 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 35 B T. A Laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears N.8*W., 84 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 34 B T.	
	Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky and clayey, 3rd and 4th rate. Timber, Fir, Cedar, Laurel and Pine. Dense undergrowth of Fir, Pine, Vinemaple, Balm, Live Oak and Vine.
