	A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.63*E., 50 lks. dist., marked S 31 1/2 S B T.	
	A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.35*E., 20 lks. dist., marked S 31 1/2 S B T.	
42.00	Top of mountain, course N.30*E and S.30*W. Steep descent.	+100
43.35	Old Township corner - it and witness trees are still standing and agree with the field notes of the same furnished by the Surveyor General. Destroy all marks referring to Township 31 S Ranges 9 and 10 on posts and witness trees along this line.	
60.00	Enter old burned timbers, course N and S.	
70.00	Draw, course SW. Along S. slope of mountain.	-100
80.00	Set a stone, 14x8x5 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, marked with six notches on the E, W and N. edges, for the cor. of Township 31 S Ranges 9 and 10 W, from which A Laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears N.50*E., 48 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 31 B T. A Fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N.70*W., 180 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 10 W S 36 B T. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky, 4th rate. Timber, scattering of Fir. Undergrowth, Fir, Manzaneta, Mountain Balm and Vines. Mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth. 80.00 chains.
