| 40.00 | Set a cedar post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. marked S 19 $\frac{1}{4}$ S on E and S 24 $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W faces, from which, A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.62*E., 13 lks. dist. marked S 19 $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.78*W., 40 lks. dist. marked S 24 $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. |
| 51.50 | A creek 1 lk. wide, course E. |
| 60.75 | A creek, 10 lks. wide, course SE. Steep ascent. |
| 80.00 | Set a Cedar post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in ground, for Cor. of Secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, marked T 31 S S 18 on NE, R 9 W S 19 on SE, R 10 W S 24 on SW and S 13 on NW faces, with 3 notches on N and S angles, from which, A Fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.35*E., 13 lks. dist. marked T 31 S R 9 W S 19 B T. A Cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears N.65*E., 48 lks. dist. marked T 31 S R 9 W S 18 B T. A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.32*W., 28 lks. dist. marked T 31 S R 10 W S 24 B T. A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.88*W., 33 lks. dist. marked T 31 S R 10 W S 13 B T. Land, mountainous. Soil, clay and stone, 3rd. and 4th. rate. Heavily timbered with Fir, Hemlock and Cedar. |
