75.00	Top of ridge, course NE and SW. Descend.	+400
80.00	Set a Yew post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of Secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15 marked T 31 S S 11 on NE, R 9 W S 14 on SE, S 15 on SW and S 10 on NW faces, also 4 notches on S and 2 notches on E. edges, from which A Yew, 8 ins. diam., bears N.68*E., 22 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 11 B T. A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.35*E., 24 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 14 B T. A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.32*W., 41 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 15 B T. A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.85*W., 44 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 10 B T. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky, 3rd rate. Timber, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock, Laurel and Chinquapin. Undergrowth, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock, Laurel and Chinquapin, Balm, Vinemaple and Hazel. Mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth. 80.00 chains.
