

SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 31 S., R 9 W.

CHAINS

Mountainous, heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth. 80.00 chains.

N.89*45'E on random line bet. Secs. 10 and 15.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner.

80.30 Intersect N and S line 14 lks. N. of corner of Secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15.

Thence I run

S.89*51'W on true line bet. Secs. 10 and 15.

Steep descent.

15.00 E. fork of Panther Creek 10 lks. wide, course S. -200

Ascend rocky bluff.

16.51 Top of same, course N and S. +500

30.00 Top of spur on line, course S. Descend. +250

32.00 Creek 1 lk. wide, course SE. -500

40.15 Marked a Chinquapin 10 ins. diam., S $10 \frac{1}{4}$ S on N and S 15 on S sides for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. from which

A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears N.30*E., 22 lks. dist., marked S $10 \frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Chinquapin, 10 ins. diam., bears S.4*W., 11 lks. dist., marked S $15 \frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

40.50 Top of spur on line, course N.85*E. + 50

Along N. slope of ridge.

62.00 Panther Ridge, course N and S. Trail along same. +100

75.00 Creek 1 lk. wide, course N.30*W. -250

80.30 The corner of Secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky and clay, 3rd rate.

Timber, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock, Chinquapin, Laurel and Yew.

Undergrowth, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock, Chinquapin, Laurel, Yew, Balm and Vinemaple.
