CHAINS

for cor. of Secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21, marked with 3 notches on S and 4 notches on E edges, from which

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.30°E., 113 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 16 B T.

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.38°E., 128 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 21 B T.

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.45°W., 100 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 20 B T.

A Fir, 80 ins. diam., bears N.32°W., 283 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 17 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 4th rate.

Timber, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock and Laurel.

Undergrowth, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock and Laurel.

Mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth. 80.00 chains.

East on random line bet. Secs. 16 and 21.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. corner.

79.64 Intersect N and S line 22 lks. S of cor. of Secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22.

Thence I run

S.89°51'W on true line between Secs. 16 and 21.

Ascend.

6.00 Summit of Panther Ridge, course N and S.

Trail along same, steep descent.

15.00 Draw course SW - ascend.

39.82 A Yew, 8 ins. diam., marked S 16  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on N and S 21  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on S faces for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. cor. from which

A Yew, 10 ins. diam., bears N.60°E., 67 lks. dist., marked S 16  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

A Chinquapin, 10 ins, diam., bears S.3°E., 62 lks. dist., marked S 21  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

45.00 A creek 1 lk. wide, course NW.
