

SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 31. S. R. 9 W.

CHAINS

Descend NE slope of mountain.

40.00 Marked a Fir, 6 ins. diam., S 20 $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on E and S 19 $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W faces for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. from which
 A Live Oak, 8 ins. diam., bears N.55*E., 20 lks. dist., marked S 20 $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
 A Live Oak, 8 ins. diam., bears N.45*W., 12 lks. dist., marked S 19 $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

72.75 Top of ridge and trail, course N.10*E and S.10*W. +300

80.00 Set a Fir post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. to Secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20 and marked T 31 S S 17 on NE, R 9 W S 20 on SE, S 19 on the SW and S 18 on the NW faces, with 3 notches on the S and 5 notches on the E edges, from which
 A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.70*E., 34 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 17 B T.
 A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.32*W., 57 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 19 B T.
 A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.35*E., 58 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 20 B T.
 A Cedar, 24 ins. diam., bears N.60*W., 57 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 9 W S 18 B T.

Land, rough mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 4th rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Pine, Laurel and Chinquapin.

Undergrowth, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Pine, Laurel, Chinquapin, Balm, Huckleberry, Live Oak and Vinemaple.

Mountainous, heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth. 80.00 chains.

N.89*55'E on Random line bet. Secs. 17 and 20.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner.

79.78 Intersect N and S line at corner of Secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21.
