Timber, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock, Pine, Chinquapin, Laurel and Yew.

Undergrowth, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock, Pine, Chinquapin, Laurel, Yew, Rhododendron, Balm, Vinemaple, Huckleberry and Salal.

Mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth. 80.00 chains.

East, on random line bet. Secs. 5 and 8.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner.

80.10 Intersect N and S line 26 lks. S of corner of Secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.

Thence I run

S.89*49'W on true line bet. Secs. 5 and 8.

Descend along N slope of mountain.

11.20 A creek, 2 lks. wide, course N.

11.75 A creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE.

38.90 A creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE.

40.05 Set a Basalt stone, 14x12x10 ins. 10 ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N face for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner, from which

A Hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears N.25*E., 40 lks. dist., marked S 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Hemlock, 9 ins. diam., bears S.15*E., 9 lks. dist., marked S 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.

60.00 Top of spur on line, course N.

Descend.

80.10 To the corner of Secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd and 4th rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Yew, Chinquapin and Laurel.

Undergrowth, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Yew, Chinquapin, Laurel, Rhododendron, Vinemaple, Balm, Huckleberry and Salal.
