A Yew, 6 ins. diam., bears N.50\*E., 15 lks. dist. mkd. T. 32 S R 1 W S 18 B T.

A Fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S.23\*E., 15 lks. dist. mkd. T 32 S R 1 W S 19 B T.

A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.18\*W.; 44 lks. dist. mkd. T 32 S R 2 W S 24 B T.

A Yew, 8 ins. diam., bears N.70\*W., 8 lks. dist. mkd. T 32 S R 2 W S 13 B T.
