40.00 Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on E. slope of hill, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face, from which

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.12*E., 20 lks. dist. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.80*W., 27 lks. dist. mkd. $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.

60.00 Creek, 3 lks. wide, runs SE. 150 ft. below $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor, and ascend.

80.00 Set a basalt stone 24x12x8 ins. 18 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 1, 11, 12 & 2, 200 ft. above last creek, mkd. with 1 notch on E. and 5 notches on S. edges, from which

A live oak, 4 ins. diam., bears S.37*E., 32 lks. dist. mkd. T 32 S R 1 W S 12 B T.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.8*W., 38 lks. dist. mkd. T 32 S R 1 W S 2 B T.
