80.00 A point about 300 ft. below  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. and set a basalt stone, 14x12x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17; mkd. with 4 notches on S. and E. edges, from which

A sugar pine, 3 ins. diam., bears N.68\*E., 28 lks. dist. mkd. T 32 S R 1 W S 9 B T.

A sugar pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S.32\*E., 15 lks. dist. mkd. T 32 S R 1 W S 16 B T.

A matherone, 8 ins. diam., bears S.40\*W., 33 lks. dist. mkd. T 32 S R 1 W S 17 B T.

A sugar pine, 3 ins. diam., bears N.58\*W., 42 lks. dist. mkd. T 32 S R 1 W S 8 B T.

Land, high and mountainous; soil, 3rd rate.

Densely covered with forest of fir, cedar and sugar pine and some live oak.

Thick undergrowth of fir, cedar, sugar pine, matherone, chinquapin, and arrowwood, 80.00 chs.

East, on a random line bet. secs. 9 and 16.

Descend, 200 ft. to

5.00 Creek, 4 lks. wide, runs North, thence along N. slope of hill.

25.85 Brook, 3 lks. wide, runs NE on hillside.

37.20 Brook, 2 lks. wide, runs N.

40.00 Set tem.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. and ascend.

65.00 A point about 400 ft. above  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. and top of ridge slopes N. and descend.

80.45 A point about 400 ft. below top of ridge, and intersect N. and S. line, 10 lks. S. of the cor. to secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16.
