A fir, 44 ins. diam., bears S.14 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*W., 57 lks. dist.

Marked T 32 S R 3 W S 24 B T.

A cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears N.30 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*W., 58 lks. dist.

Marked T 32 S R 3 W S 13 B T.

No other tree in limits.

Mound and pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly, third rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, laurel, vine maple and huckleberry.

Mountainous land, 80.00 chs.

North, between secs. 13 and 18.

Descend along West slope of mountain, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

7.50 Ridge point, 400 ft. above Cow Creek, bears N.80\*W., and S.80\*E. Descend into canyon.

44.50 Creek, 10 lks. wide, in canyon, 400 ft. deep, course S.80\*W. Ascend.

60.25 Descend into Cow Creek Canyon.

80.00 Set an ironstone, 24x15x10 ins., 18 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, marked with 2 notches on N. and 4 notches on S. edges, from which

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N.36\*E., 41 lks. dist.

Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 7 B T.

A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S.71 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E., 105 lks.

Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 18 B T.

No other trees in limits. Mound and pits impracticable on account of steepness of ground.
