

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

West Bdy. of T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly, third rate.

Timber, fir and pine with some cedar and hemlock.

Undergrowth, laurel.

Mountainous land, 80.00 chs.

North, between secs. 7 and 12.

Descend into Cow Creek, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

4.00 Foot of mountain, 400 ft. below top of ridge, bears NE. and SW. Cow Creek, 50 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course NE.

5.15 Cow Creek, 50 lks. wide, course NW.

Ascend along W. slope of mountain.

10.25 Descend into Cow Creek, again.

12.50 Cow Creek, 50 lks. wide, course N.30*E. Ascend along E. slope of mountain.

18.25 Descend along W. slope of mountain.

28.00 Top of divide between forks of Cow Creek, 200 ft. high, descend toward the West. Descend into Cow Creek.

35.25 N. fork Cow Creek, 25 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course S.70*W. Ascend.

35.50 Dim trail, bears E. and W.

40.00 A fir, 10 ins. diam., for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 12 on the W. and S 7 on the E. faces, from which
 A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 45 lks. dist.
 Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
 A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.70*W., 13 lks. dist.
 Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

45.45 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, in ravine, 100 ft. deep, course S.60*W.
