

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS	
	Descend along S. slope of mountain through scattering timber and undergrowth.
8.10	Brink of perpendicular bluffs, 150 ft. high, bears N.20°E. and S.20°W.
11.50	Creek, 3 lks. wide, in canyon, 300 ft. deep, course S.60°E. Most all water sinks just above line. Ascend along N. slope of mountain.
20.50	Descend along N. slope.
33.65	Lame creek, 10 lks. wide in canyon, 200 ft. deep, course N.80°E. Ascend gradually along S. slope of mountain.
38.00	Maybel Simons Cabin bears N. about 30 lks. dist.
40.007	Set an ironstone, 28x20x10 ins., 21 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which A sugar pine, 60 ins. diam., bears S.1°W., 45 lks. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 B T. A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.2 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 40 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 25 B T.
48.25	Rogue River Trail, bears N. and S.
58.25	Ridge point, 100 ft. above creek, descends toward the SE. Descend.
62.35	Creek, 2 lks. wide, in canyon, 150 ft. deep, course S.60°E. Most all water sinks just above line. Ascend along N. slope of mountain.
70.88	A fir, 30 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on E. and W. sides.
80.14	The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36. Land, mountainous. Soil, stony, shaly and fourth rate. Timber, fir, sugar pine, oak and matherone. Undergrowth, laurel, vine maple, oak, grubs and buck brush. Mountainous land.
