

Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS	
	N.0°01'W., between secs. 25 and 26. Over rolling ground through scattering timber and undergrowth.
10.50	Creek, 3 lks. wide, in canyon, 150 ft. deep, course S.70°E. Ascend gradually over broken ground.
27.64	Rogue River trail, bears E. and W.
40.00	Set an ironstone, 36x15x12 ins., 27 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face, from which A chinquapin, 8 ins. diam., bears S.67 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 13 lks. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 25 B T. A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.28°W., 54 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 26 B T.
48.80	Creek, 5 lks. wide, in ravine, 100 ft. deep, course S.60°E.
59.60	Cushman's trail, bears E. and W.
78.54	A fir, 28 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
80.00	Set a basalt stone, 24x10x8 ins., 18 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25, and 26, marked with 2 notches on S. and 1 notch on E. edges, from which A yew, 8 ins. diam., bears N.8°E., 30 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 24 B T. A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.57 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 105 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 25 B T. A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears S.30°W., 79 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 26 B T. A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.80 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 71 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 23 B T.
	Land, rolling. Soil, sandy and gravelly, second and third rates. Timber, sugarpine, fir and yew. Undergrowth, laurel, small firs, fern and huckle berry. Densely covered with undergrowth.
