

Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS	
	N.0°01'W., between secs. 23 and 24.
	Ascend gradually S. slope of mountain through heavy timber and undergrowth.
0.75	A fir, 36 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
18.00	Steeper ascent.
28.20	Leave heavy timber and enter old burn, bears E. and W.
33.00	Leave burn and enter heavy live timber, bears E. and W.
40.00	Set an ironstone, 24x12x8 ins., 18 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on W. face, from which A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.86°E., 45 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S 24 B T. A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.33°W., 43 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S 23 B T.
55.00	Summit of divide between Rogue and Umpqua Rivers, 500 ft. above Trail Creek, bears E. and W. Descend N. slope gradually.
80.00	Set an ironstone, 24x12x10 ins., 18 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24, marked with 3 notches on S. and one notch on E. edges, from which A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears N.73 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 113 lks. Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 13 B T. A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.23°E., 54 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 24 B T. A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.33°W., 64 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 23 B T. A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.4 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 70 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 14 B T.
	Land, rolling and mountainous.
	Soil, sandy, second rate.
	Timber, fir, sugar pine, yellow pine, yew and hemlock.
	Undergrowth, laurel, vine maple, sallow, and huckleberry.
	Mountainous and heavily timbered lands.
