## Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

## CHAINS

Thence, I run N.0°01'W., between secs. 13 and 14.

Descend N. slope of mountain through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

35.59 A fir, 48 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.

40.00 Set an ironstone, 15x12x8 ins., 10 ins. in ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the W. face, from which

A hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears S.66°E., 18 lks.

Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 13 B T.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.61 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 31 lks. dis.

Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 14 B T.

44.00 A fir, 60 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.

51.20 Creek, 4 lks. wide, in ravine, 50 ft. deep, course N.80°E.

80.00 Set an ironstone, 18x12x8 ins., 12 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, marked with 4 notches on S. and one notch on E. edges, from which

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.79°E., 97 lks. dist.

Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 12 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.60 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 72 lks. dist.

Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 13 B T.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.59°W., 24 lks. dist.

Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 14 B T.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.42°W., 29 lks. dist.

Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 11 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly, third rate.

Timber, fir, sugar, pine, and hemlock.

Undergrowth, laurel, blackberry and small firs.

Heavily timbered lands.
