CHAINS	
5.60	Log Cabin bears N., 10 lks. dist. slope of mt. over ridges and ravines.
36.10	Creek, 10 lks. wide, in ravine, 100 ft. deep, course N.20*W.
40.02½	A fir, 10 ins. diam., for ½ sec. cor., marked ¼ S 12 on the N. and S. 13 on the S., from which A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.50*E., 44 lks. dist. Marked ¼ S B T. A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.1½*W., 32 lks. dist. Marked ¼ S B T.
47.50	Leave heavy timber, bears N. and S. and enter old burn, some live trees standing.
51.00	Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, in ravine, 25 ft. deep, course N.60*W.
51.50	Leave old burn and enter heavy timber, bears N. and S.
80.05	The cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14. Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy, second rate. Timber, fir, hemlock and yellow pine. Undergrowth, laurel, vine maple and huckleberry. Mountains and heavily timbered lands.
	N.0*01'W., between secs. 11 and 12. Descend gradually into Mitchell's canyon, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
24.30	A fir, 60 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
38.40	Mitchell Creek, 8 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, in canyon, 300 ft. deep, course N.80*E. Ascend S. slope of ridge.
40.00	A yew, 18 ins. diam., for ½ sec. cor., marked ¼ S 11 on W. and S 12 on E., faces, from which A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N.81*W., 56 lks. dist. Marked ¼ S B T. A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 30 lks. dist. Marked ¼ S B T.
