## Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

## CHAINS

- 80.04 The cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27.  
Land, rolling and mountainous.  
Soil, gravelly, second and third rate.  
Timber, fir, sugar pine and hemlock.  
Undergrowth, laurel, vine maple and small firs.  
Mountainous and heavily timbered lands.
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- N.0\*02'W., between secs. 22 and 23.  
Descend N. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.
- 1.60 Foot of ravine, 100 ft. deep, course S.60\*E.
- 11.50 Enter heavy timber, bears E. and W.
- 21.12 A fir, 60 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
- 39.10 Ravine, 50 ft. deep, course S.60\*E.
- 40.00 Set an ironstone, 28x12x10 ins., 21 ins. in ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the W. face, from which  
A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.25\*E., 34 lks. dist.  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 23 B T.  
A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.35\*W., 10 lks. dist.  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 22 B T.
- 41.25 A fir, 36 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
- 55.00 Summit of divide between Rogue and Umpqua River, 600 ft. above Trail Creek, bears NW. and SE.
- 60.05 Rogue River trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 61.10 Enter S. end of Long Prairie, bears E. and W. Descend gradually.
- 62.50 Lane trail, bears NE. and SW.
- 65.00 Trail bears N. and SE. Thence along trail.
- 70.10 Leave trail, bears N.10\*W. and S.
- 75.00 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, in ravine, 5 ft. deep, course NW.
- 78.00 Leave Long Prairie, bears NW. SE. and enter scattering timber and dense undergrowth.
