

Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

- 58.25 Top of ascent, 100 ft. above Mitchell's Creek, bears E. and W. Descend gradually.
- 74.50 Enter dense undergrowth, bears NW. and SE.
- 79.41 A fir, 60 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
- 80.00 Set a fir post, 4 ins. sq., 3 ft. long, 24 ins. in ground, for cor. to secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15, marked T 32 S S 11 on NE., R 2 W S 14 on SE., S 15 on SW. and S 10 on NW. faces, with 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on E. edges, from which
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.46\*E., 23 lks. dist.  
Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 11 B T.
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.32\*E., 115 lks. dist.  
Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 14 B T.
- A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.10 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*W., 13 lks. dist.  
Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 15 B T.
- A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.40\*W., 34 lks. dist.  
Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 10 B T.
- Land, rolling.
- Soil, sandy, second rate.
- Timber, fir, hemlock and yellow pine.
- Undergrowth, laurel, and vine maple. Heavily timbered land.
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- Thence, I run S.89\*53'E., on random line bet. secs. 11 & 14.
- 40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.
- 80.10 Intersect N. and S. line, 44 lks. S. of cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, and 14.
- Thence, I run S.89\*48'W., on true line bet. secs. 11 and 14.
- Over rolling ground through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 1.51 A fir, 40 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on E. and W. sides.
- 35.25 Foot of ravine, 100 ft. deep, course N.5\*W.
- 37.00 Top of stony backbone, 100 ft. high, descends toward the North. Descend into Mitchell's Creek.
