CHAINS

- 40.00 Set ironstone, 24x12x4 ins., 18 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, from which
 A pine, 30 ins. diam., bears N.10*E., 63 lks. dist.
 Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 11 B T.
 A pine, 16 ins. diam., bears N.43 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 85 lks. dist.
 Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 10 B T.
- 49.50 Foot of mountain, 400 ft. below top of ridge, bears E. and W. over rolling ground.
- 49.55 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.80*E.
- 63.00 Enter swamp and scattering timber bears E. and W.
- 65.00 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N.60*E.
 Leave swamp, bears E. and SW. and ascend S. slope of mountain.
- 80.00 Set a basalt stone, 24x15x8 ins., 18 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11, marked with 5 notches on S. and 2 notches on E. edges, from which
 A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.20*E., 120 lks. dist.
 Marked T 32 S R.2 W S 2 B T.
 A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.70*E., 50 lks. dist.
 Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 11 B T.
 A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S.18*W., 61 lks. dist.
 Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 10 B T.
- No NW. tree in limits.
 Mound and pits impracticable.
 Land, rolling and mountainous.
 Soil, sandy, loam and gravelly, first and third rate.
 Timber, fir, hemlock and pine.
 Undergrowth, laurel, vine maple, salmon berry and blackberry.
 Heavily timbered lands.
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- N.89*48'E., on random line between secs. 2 and 11.
- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 80.14 Intersect N. and S. line, 14 lks. S. of cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.
