

Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

- 8.50 Leave heavy timber, bears E. and W. and enter dense laurel thicket.
  - 18.00 Leave thicket, bears E. and W. and enter heavy timber.
  - 22.15 A fir, 24 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
  - 40.00 Set basalt stone, 30x10x6 ins., 23 ins. in ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the W. face, from which
    - A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.24\*E., 8 lks. dist.
    - Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 21 B T.
    - A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N.60 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*W, 39 lks. dist.
    - Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 31 B T.
  - 61.25 Spring branch, 3 lks. wide, in ravine, 200 ft. deep, course N.30\*E. Thence over small ridges and ravines.
  - 98.33 Intersect S. Bdy. of T. 31 S R 2 W., 150 lks. E. of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. on the S. bdy. of sec. 35. At point of intersection set a basalt stone, 28x12x6 ins., 21 ins. in ground, for closing corners of secs. 2 and 3, marked C. C. on S. face, with 2 grooves on E. and 4 grooves on W. faces, from which
    - A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.29 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E., 56 lks. dist.
    - Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 21 B T.
    - A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.19\*W., 94 lks. dist.
    - Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 35 B T.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, gravelly, third rate.
- Timber, fir, hemlock and sugar pine.
- Undergrowth, laurel, vine maple, huckleberry and sallow.
- Mountains and heavily timbered lands.
- 
- Thence, I run N.0\*03'W., between secs. 33 and 34.
- Ascend S. slope of mountain, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 20.25 Ridge point, 200 ft. above sec. cor., descends toward the SE. Ascend along E. slope of ridge on S. slope of mountain.
