

Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

- 37.81 A fir, 40 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
- 40.00 Set an ironstone, 24x12x8 ins., 18 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face, from which
A cedar, 18 ins. diam., bears N.52°E., 54 lks. dist.
Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 B T.
A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.79°W., 29 lks. dist.
Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 33 B T.
- 59.00 Foot of ravine, 200 ft. deep, course S.60°E.
- 60.03 A fir, 28 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides. Over small ridges and ravines.
- 78.75 Top of ridge point, 300 ft. above sec. cor. bears E. and W. Descend gradually.
- 80.00 Set an ironstone, 28x15x5 ins., 21 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33, and 34, marked with 1 notch on the S. and 3 notches on the E. edges, from which
A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.20°E., 30 lks. dist.
Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 27 B T.
A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.10°E., 17 lks. dist.
Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 34 B T.
A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.28°W., 23 lks. dist.
Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 33 B T.
A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.64°W., 10 lks. dist.
Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 28 B T.
- Land, mountainous.
Soil, gravelly, third rate.
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar and yellow pine.
Undergrowth, laurel, vine maple and huckle berry.
Mountainous and heavily timbered lands.

- East, on a random line between secs. 27 and 34.
- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 79.80 Intersect N. and S. line, 16 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35.
Thence, I run S.89°53'W. on a true line between secs. 27 and 34.
