CHAINS

- 40.00 Set an ironstone, 18x12x6 ins., 12 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face, from which
 A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.15*E., 23 lks. dist.
 Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 21 B T.
 A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.19 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 48 lks. dist.
 Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 20 B T.
- 41.12 A fir, 60 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
- 50.50 Cow Creek, 10 lks. wide, cold water, swift current, in canyon, 300 ft. deep, course N.60*W. Ascend over small ridges and ravines.
- 75.20 Spring branch, 3 lks. wide, in ravine, 150 ft. deep, course S.70*W.
- 80.00 Set a basalt stone, 24x12x10 ins., 18 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22, marked with 3 notches on S. and E. edges, from which
 A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.74*E., 57 lks. dist.
 Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 15 B T.
 A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.59 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 43 lks. dist.
 Marked T 32 S R 3 W S 22 B T.
 A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.6*W., 12 lks. dist.
 Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 23 B T.
 A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.27 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 31 lks. dist.
 Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 16 B T.
- Land, rolling and mountainous.
 Soil, sandy and gravelly, second and third rates.
 Timber, fir, hemlock and pine.
 Undergrowth, huckleberry and laurel.
 Mountainous and heavily timbered lands.
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- N.89*48'E. on a random line between secs. 15 and 22.
- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
