

Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

- 79.70 Intersect N. and S. line, 26 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23.
Thence, I run S.89°59'W. on a true line between secs. 15 and 22.
Descend gradually through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 0.25 Long Prairie, bears NE. and South.
Thence, over level prairie land.
- 1.90 Rogue River trail, bears N. and S.
- 2.00 Ravine, 3 ft. deep, course N.20°E. Water in holes.
- 4.50 Leave Long Prairie, bears N. and S. and enter heavy timbers and dense undergrowth.
- 39.85 Set an ironstone, 24x12x6 ins., 18 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the N. face, from which
A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S.29°E., 56 lks. dist.
Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 22 B T.
A fir, 44 ins. diam., bears N.23°W., 60 lks. dist.
Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 15 B T.
- 45.00 Divide bet. Cow Creek and Elk Creek, 100 ft. above Long Prairie, bears N. and S.
- 47.03 A fir, 36 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
- 52.00 Steeper descent into Cow Creek Basin.
- 79.70 The cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22.
Land, level and mountainous.
Soil. sandy and gravelly, second and third rates.
Timber, fir, hemlock and yellow pine.
Undergrowth, laurel.
Mountainous and heavily timbered land.
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- N.0°02'W., between secs. 15 and 16.
Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
