

Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

- 2.60 Ravine, 100 ft. deep, course SW. Ascend S. slope of divide.
- 5.35 A fir, 48 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
- 25.00 Summit of divide, between Cow Creek and Umpqua River, 350 ft. above Cow Creek, bears N.60*W. and S.60*E. Descend over ridges and ravines.
- 40.00 Set an ironstone, 28x10x8 ins., 21 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face, from which
 A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.80*E., 24 lks. dist.
 Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 15 B T.
 A sugar pine, 40 ins. diam., bears S.70*W., 14 lks.
 Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 15 B T.
- 49.10 A fir, 28 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
- 59.80 Head of large spring branch runs S.60*W.
- 74.45 Spring branch, 3 lks. wide in ravine, 100 ft. deep, course NW.
- 80.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x12x6 ins., 12 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16, marked with 4 notches on S. and 3 notches on E. edges, from which
 A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.75*E., 48 lks. dist.
 Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 10 B T.
 A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.46*E., 25 lks. dist.
 Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 15 B T.
 A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.48*W., 16 lks. dist.
 Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 16 B T.
 A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.64*E., 25 lks. dist.
 Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 9 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy second rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock and sugar pine.

Undergrowth, laurel, huckle berry and sallow.

Mountainous and heavily timbered lands.
