

Subdivisions T. 32 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS	
47.00	More gradual ascent of mountain.
71.00	Summit of divide between Cow Creek and Umpqua River, 350 ft. above Cow Creek, bears NW. and SE. Descend gradually along NE. slope of mountain.
80.00	Set a quartz stone, 24x15x10 ins., 18 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, marked with 4 notches on S. and E. edges, from which A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.26 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 107 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 9 B T. A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S.85*E., 91 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 16 B T.  No other tree in limits. Mound and pits impracticable. Land, mountainous. Soil, gravelly, third rate. Timber, scattering fir, hemlock and sugar pine. Mountainous land. Undergrowth, laurel.
	Thence, I run S.89*59'E., on a random line between secs. 9 and 16.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.
80.10	Intersect N. and S. line, 23 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16. Thence, I run S.89*51'W., on a true line between secs. 9 and 16. Descend W. slope through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
2.14	Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, in ravine, 10 ft. deep, course N.10*W.
12.25	Foot of mountain, 200 ft. below sec. cor., bears N.60*W., S.60*E.
12.25	Drews Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N.60*W. Ascend gradually along N. slope of mountain.
25.30	Creek, 4 lks. wide, in ravine, 50 ft. deep, course N.30*W.
