Set an ironstone, 18x12x6 ins., 12 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, marked with 2 notches on S. and 5 notches on E. edges, from which

A hemlock, 30 ins. diam., bears N.50°E., 30 lks.

Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 20 B T.

A hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears S.14°E., 64 lks.

Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 29 B T.

A hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears S.20°W., 29 lks.

Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 30 B T.

A hemlock, 28 ins. diam., bears N.6 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 68 lks.

Marked T 32 S R 2 W S 19 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly, third rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock and sugar pine.

Undergrowth, laurel, huckle berry and vine maple.

Mountainous and densely overgrown lands.

S.89°54'E. on a random line between secs. 20 and 29.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

80.02 Intersect N. and S. line, 9 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29.

Thence, I run N.89°58'W. on a true line between secs.

20 and 29. Descend along NW. slope through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

11.25 Ridge point, 50 ft. below sec. cor., bears NW. and SE.

Steeper descent into Cushman's Basin.

40.01 A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 20 on N. and S 29 on S. faces, from which

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.14°E., 54 lks. dist.

Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

A hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears S.72°W., 37 lks. dist.

Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

43.75 Foot of descent, 250 ft. below ridge point, bears N. and S.

Swamp, bears N. and S.
