Mountainous land.</p> <hr/> <p>Thence, I run S.89*59'W., on a random line between secs. 18 and 19.</p> <p>40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.</p> <p>80.14 Intersect W. Bdy. of the Tp. 28 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24.</p> <p>Thence, I run S.89*49'E. on a true line between secs. 18 and 19. Ascend W. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.</p> <p>7.25 Top of ridge, 50 ft. above sec. cor., bears N.20*W. and South. Descend into canyon.</p> <p>15.20 Creek, 8 lks. wide, in canyon, 250 ft. deep, course N.30*W.</p> <p>17.25 Spring branch, 3 lks. wide, in ravine, 30 ft. deep, course N.30*W. Ascend.</p> <p>18.00 Leave timber, bears N. and S.</p> <p>40.14 Set a basalt stone, 24x12x4 ins., 18 ins. in ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on N. face. Raise mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor. Pits impracticable.</p> <p>43.00 More gradual ascent. Enter scattering timber, bears N. and S.</p> <p>76.25 Summit of mountain, 200 ft. above creek, bears N. and S. Descend gradually.</p> <p>80.14 The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20.</p> <p>Land, mountainous.</p> <p>Soil, sandy and gravelly, second and third rate.</p> <p>Timber, fir, hemlock, and sugar pine.</p> <p>Undergrowth, laurel, and huckle berry.</p> <p>Mountainous land.</p> <hr/> <p>N.0*05'W., between secs. 17 and 18.</p> <p>Descend through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.</p> <p>1.00 Enter heavy timber, bears E. and W.</p> <p>22.60 Creek, 5 lks. wide, in canyon, 200 ft. deep, course N.50*W.
